Yes, we are asking you to travel "all the way" to Burrillville, but you won't want to miss this! The Stillwater Mill is being converted by NeighborWorks Blackstone River Valley into mixed-income apartments and received \$1.2 million in bond funding for its 36 affordable apartments.

**Directions:**

From Providence: Take Route 295 North to Exit 8B, Route 7 North. Follow Route 7 North for approximately 8 miles. At the flashing yellow light, bear right on Route 7 and continue until the next full signal intersection. Turn left onto Route 102 and proceed for about 2 miles. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Route 107/East Avenue. The entrance to Stillwater Mill is at the new town library just before the Town Hall Annex (35C East Avenue) and Millhouse Restaurant.
